Participants will take a Yellow Belt Certification exam as part of this course, certifying their knowledge of the *Lean Six Sigma* process and ability to apply this process and the tools.

Professionals can also take up Six Sigma Green and Black Belt certifications as well and can attain higher belt rankings.
